Co-founder of MNYC, an organization that centers leadership development of the new generation of movement leaders, leveraging electoral work and issue advocacy as tactics to create a more equitable and just state for all people.



Part of a team at New Era Colorado, which ran a large scale voter registration program reaching high school students, particularly students of color, across the state, and educating them on the state's 2020 law which lowered the voting age to 17.



Empowers youth to use their voice in shaping their future. MOVE Texas, the brainchild behind Charlie's drive to combat voter suppression, has helped young voters across 22 campuses in Texas.



Once a youth organizer, Douglas is now the Deputy Director of MOVE TEXAS, where she aims to change the fact that Texas is one of the most difficult states to register to vote.

Founder of Generation Vote, where she mobilizes and connects young people to become agents of change in local electoral and advocacy campaigns. Co-Chair of the Let NY Vote Youth Voting Rights Working Group, responsible for passing the first NY voter reform laws in over 100 years.



Organizer with Leaders Igniting
Transformation, a Wisconsin
group led by youth of color that
goes beyond just registering
young people to vote, to also
engaging them to become
involved in every aspect of
democracy. Their efforts
persuaded the Milwaukee school
board to end its contract with the
Police Department in June 2020.
